She was suggested for knee replacement surgery and with fear of it, she was looking out for alternate treatment options. That is when she visited Rajarajeswari Medical College & Hospital, where she was seen by Dr Anagha M V, Assistant Professor in department of Anaesthesiology and Interventional Pain Specialist. A new and latest pain relief technique called Radio frequency ablation was planned. Dr.Anagha is only among the very few doctors trained in performing such a procedure in Bengaluru city. The Radiofrequency ablation for pain relief of knee pain was done in 1 hour in operation theatre and the patient was discharge the same day with complete pain relief.

10. Kudos to the Doctors of Rajarajeswari Medical college and Hospital from the Department of ENT, Head and Neck Surgery who have successfully operated on a 32 year, male patient with Giant impacted tonsillar stone (Tonsillolith) in the right tonsil which measured 3.4 cm x 2.6cm x 2.7 cm.

Tonsillolith are caused by food particles, bacteria, and mucus which may get trapped in small pockets or crypts of the tonsils. The particles and bacteria can get trapped due to improper oral hygiene or the structure of the tonsils. When this trapped material builds up, it can cause swelling and soreness.

ENT Surgeon, Dr. Rajendran Dinesh Kumar, repaired the blockage by Nasal Septal Cross-Over Flap Technique by Endoscopic Surgical Repair, which is completely scar less, stent less surgery. Newborn withstood the procedure well and was under

Neonatal ICU care, subsequently breastfed 5 days after the surgery without any respiratory distress. Endoscopic examinations 2 weeks after surgery showed the choana to be free of blockage. Regular clinical and nasal endoscopic examination has been planned during follow up visits to the hospital for child's routine care and vaccination sessions.
